General Scope of Project

Wingate provided support to Royal Engineers with design engineering, contract administration and construction management services for the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans' Water Line Rehabilitation and Replacement Program for The Little Woods Neighborhood in New Orleans East.

The general purpose of the program is to replace the waterlines in the Little Woods neighborhood of New Orleans that were damaged by flooding caused by Hurricane Katrina. The program is one of the most coordination specific programs in the City's history, involving the required coordination of several key Federal, State, and Municipal agencies. The program depends heavily upon the coordination between New Orleans Department of Public Works road restoration crews, and the Sewerage and Water Board's waterline replacement contractors.
